NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial. This trial is sanctioned by the Australian Shepherd Club of America (ASCA®) with the Three Rivers Working Australian Association, Inc. (TRWASA) as the sponsor club. Exhibitors through submission of their entry acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, including the following rules regarding entry.

- Bitches in heat, lame or blind dogs are ineligible for entry.
- Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside the ring or outside the ring, must be excused from the trial.
- I (we) further agree that when my dog(s) are left unattended, they will be secured in a crate or x-pen. Owners/handlers whose dogs are tethered or improperly secured will not be allowed on the grounds.
- No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from ASCA obedience trials; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a member not in good standing with ASCA.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- Participation is a privilege afforded by the Host club and may be extended or withdrawn by the Host club's trial committee on suitable cause only. Refusal of such entries will be reported to ASCA.

From I-5 Southbound: Take Exit 294 (Hwy 99W toward Newberg). Go 16 miles on Hwy 99W into Newberg. When Hwy 99W becomes one-way in Newberg, stay in the right lane. This will become a right-turn only onto Hwy 240. Turn right (north) onto Hwy 240 (it will make a left curve and then head west). Go 10 miles on Hwy 240 then turn left (south) onto Major Lane (it's a gravel road). Go 0.3 miles. 16493 Major Lane is on the right. There is a 3-rail white fence around the property.

From I-5 Northbound: Take Exit 278 (Aurora). At the end of the ramp, turn left onto Ehlen Rd (west). Go 7 miles (The road will change names to Yergen Rd, then McKay Rd.). When you come to a "T", turn right onto Hwy 219 (River Rd) north toward Newberg. Go 5.2 miles on Hwy 219. Follow Hwy 219 (also called Villa Rd in Newberg) as it makes a right turn. At the stop light, turn left (west) onto Hwy 99W. When Hwy 99W becomes one-way in Newberg, stay in the right lane. This will become a right-turn only onto Hwy 240. Turn right (north) onto Hwy 240 (it will make a left curve and then head west). Go 10 miles on Hwy 240 then turn left (south) onto Major Lane (it's a gravel road). Go 0.3 miles. 16493 Major Lane is on the right. There is a 3-rail white fence around the property.

From McMinnville: Take Hwy 99W east to the east end of McMinnville. Turn left (north) onto Hwy 47. Go 8 miles on Hwy 47 into Yamhill. At the blinking light in Yamhill, turn right (east) onto Hwy 240. Go about 1.7 miles and turn right (south) onto Major Lane (it's a gravel road). Go 0.3 miles. 16493 Major Lane is on the right. There is a 3-rail white fence around the property.

From Hwy 26 / Banks / Forest Grove area: Take Hwy 47 South. When you get to the flashing light in Yamhill, turn left (east) onto Hwy 240. Go about 1.7 miles and turn right (south) onto Major Lane (it's a gravel road). Go 0.3 miles. 16493 Major Lane is on the right. There is a 3-rail white fence around the property
